Products can be dropped off no later than 10 AM on Monday, January 27, 2020, at any UVM Extension Office; NRCD Office in Newport; or FSA Office in White River Jct.; or brought to the VT Farm Show Monday, January 27<sup>th</sup> between 9 AM to 4 PM.

### Honey

- 120) One comb, section or cut
- 121) One, 1-lb jar of honey, extracted, light
- 122) One, 1-lb jar of honey, extracted, amber
- 123) One, 1-lb jar of honey, extracted, dark
- 124) One, 1-lb jar of chunk honey
- 125) One, 1-lb jar of creamed honey
- 126) One, opaque glass or ceramic jar, any color honey
- 127) Honey Cookery Show

### Christmas Tree Categories

- 130) One, 6 to 8 foot Balsam Fir
- 131) One, 6 to 8 foot Fraser Fir
- 133) One, 6 to 8 foot Other Type

### Wreaths

- 140) One, 12 inch (metal ring diameter) double faced evergreen wreath decorated or undecorated

### Fiber & Wool

- 180) One, 2-oz skein of white or natural color-VT Wool Yarn-2-ply Lace Weight (15 or more wpi.)
- 181) One, 2-oz skein of white or natural color Vt Wool Yarn-2-ply Fingering or Sport Weight (12-15 wpi.)
- 182) One, 2-oz skein of white or natural color Vt Wool Yarn-2-ply DK/Worsted Weight (8-12 wpi.)
- 183) One, 2-oz skein of Llama, or Alpaca Yarn, Spinner's choice.
- 184) One, 2-oz skein of Novelty Yarn comprised of Vt wool/alpaca/llama and/or other textile fibers, Spinner's choice.

### Field Crops:

#### Silage

- 191) Corn Silage-1 quart jar
- 192) Haylage – Grass-1 quart jar
- 193) Haylage – Legume-1 quart jar
- 194) Round bale Haylage – Baleage-1 quart jar, or Ziploc bag

#### Grain

- 195) Ear Corn/High Moisture Corn - Ground -1 quart jar
- 196) Corn Grain - Whole Kernel-1 quart jar
- 197) Cereal Grain (wheat/barley/oats/rye)-1 quart jar
- 198) Other Dry Grain (soybean, oilseed, other)-1 quart jar

#### Hay

- 201) Legume Hay - 1st cut – one 1/8 bale
- 202) Mixed Hay - 1st cut – one 1/8 bale
- 203) Grass Hay – 1st cut – one 1/8 bale
- 204) Legume Hay - 2nd cut – one 1/8 bale
- 205) Mixed Hay - 2nd cut – one 1/8 bale
- 206) Grass Hay - 2nd cut – one 1/8 bale

### Maple Products

- 210) Indian Sugar (dry granulated) - 1 package
- 211) Maple Cream - 1 package
- 212) Maple Sugar Cakes - 1 package
- 213) Pure Maple Fudge with recipe (may contain cream, nuts, butter) - 1 package
- 214) Maple Specialty – using real VT maple syrup (Recipe must be submitted with entry)

### Maple Syrup

- 220) 1 pint Grade A Golden Color, Delicate Taste
- 221) 1 pint Grade A Amber Color, Rich Taste
- 222) 1 pint Grade A Dark Color, Robust Taste
- 223) 1 pint Grade A Very Dark Color, Strong Flavor

### Home Products – Culinary (with Recipe)

- 301) Yeast Breads - 1 loaf (may contain nuts, raisins, etc.)
- 302) Muffins – 6 (may contain nuts, raisins, etc.)
- 303) Quick Breads -1 loaf (may contain nuts, raisins, etc.)
- 304) Cake any type frosted or unfrosted
- 305) One or Two crust pie – any flavor
- 306) Casserole featuring a Vermont product
- 307) Donuts – 6
- 308) Cookies featuring a Vermont product – 8-10

### Home Products – Specialty (with Recipe)

- 309) Jam
- 310) Jelly
- 311) Relishes & Pickles – sweet, sour, dill, etc.
- 312) Salsa
- 313) Any other canned vegetable/fruit

### Home Products – Eggs

- 314) One dozen large white
- 315) One dozen large brown
